



Seed Money for Watershed Projects

- \$10k available for high priority public engagement, awareness raising, behavior change, incentive and/or compliance projects
- In the past year we funded the Civic Engagement Toolkit
- Will need a process to nominate and decide on funding, likely the funding decision will be made by the PRWC

ERP Implementation/Evaluation

- Carrying on the work based on ERP Focus Area Meetings last year
- Reviewing ERP Key Plans, Successes, and Priority Actions for each chapter:

Equity and Human Wellbeing	Salmon	Floodplains	Farms and Agricultural Land
Climate Change	Estuaries	Forests	Stormwater and Water Quality

- Goal is to adaptively manage the ERP (not a full update) with the support of the LIO
 - Update status of all ERP items (strategies, plans, priority actions)
 - O Bring together regional partners to provide input to better focus priority actions (e.g., identify the top 3-5 that the LIO is going to work on moving forward in the next few years)
 - Work on a path forward to further define and advocate for funding and other needs for priority actions
